Whole community catechesis is an approach to parish or school religious education through which youth and adults, as well as children, are invited to participate in faith formation programs throughout the year. The entire community thus becomes the focus of all we do in catechesis.

Catechesis is for adults as much as for children; in short, catechesis is the work of the whole community.

We have scheduled five (5) opportunities for whole community catechesis. Each session will include Saturday evening mass and a meal in Gillen Hall. We will be following a theme each month, around the time of the church year or a significant part of Christian living.

Saturday, October 3, 2009 ~ “Faith, Tradition and the Domestic Church”

Saturday, November 21, 2009 ~ “Advent Festival”

Saturday, December 12, 2009 ~ “Movie Night”

Saturday, February 6, 2010 ~ “Our Relationship with God through Prayer”

Saturday, March 6, 2010 ~ “A Lenten Supper”

Each session will begin with mass at 5:00 PM, followed by dinner at 6:00 PM, followed by a catechetical session.

Cost will be \$5.00 per person, not to exceed \$20.00 per family
