

## Sources of Hope:

The generosity of our parishioners helped to uplift our parish this year. The record-breaking 2022 Diocesan Lenten Appeal supported outreach to seniors, infants and expectant mothers, and the sick and homebound here in Trafford and throughout the four counties of our Diocese. As the need continues to be great, we will continue to need your support.

Over the last year, we saw a noticeable increase in our offertory. A strong and consistent offertory year-round is essential for our parish to function well. Thanks to everyone who made it possible! This year also saw the return of the Saint Regis Parish Festival after a decade-long absence. We realized a profit of over \$12,000; but, just as importantly, it was a wonderful to see longtime and newer parishioners to get to know one another better by working together.

So many folks in the larger Trafford/Level Green community, many of whom remember our festivals of years past, were happy to see it come back! Our 2023 festival is scheduled for July 21-22; planning will begin shortly after the start of the new year.

I also call your attention to the National Eucharistic Revival, a three-year initiative to show as many people as possible what wonders the True Presence of Jesus can do to heal the heart and soul. Look for more information about adoration and reconciliation opportunities locally to help confront the hardships that we face in everyday life. The National Eucharistic Revival is a powerful, uplifting way to rise to these challenges.

## Capital Improvements:

Your contributions to our parish through offertory and the Diocesan Lenten Appeal help maintain the facility, making it the center of prayer in our community.

Over the last three years, we upgraded the light fixtures in the church to high-efficiency LED lighting, replaced the seriously outdated electrical panels throughout the complex, successfully addressed a leak in one of the foundation walls of the church building, updated the controls for the heating and air conditioning system in the complex, and completed several other smaller needs.
